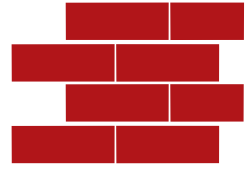


PAPER PLATE PIZZA



MATERIALS FOR 1 PAPER PLATE PIZZA:

2 Paper Plates
Craft Foam
Construction Paper
Glue Stick
Craft Glue
Scissor
Printout of Page with Flags (included - optional)



DIRECTIONS:

First, the legend and your flag.

1. Legend has it that while traveling in Naples, Italy's Queen Margherita was eating a strange dish and asked a local chef to cook it for her. In honor of the queen, the chef based his dish on the colors of the Italian flag: red, green and white. He used red (tomatoes), white (mozzarella cheese), and green (basil). To this day, this type of pie is called a Margherita Pizza!
2. Choose a flag for your pizza and identify its colors (or draw your own flag)!

Next, make the sauce and toppings.

3. Cut out the inner circle of the first plate and trace it on construction paper that is the color of your "sauce". Cut out your sauce and glue it to the other plate.
4. Using craft foam and construction paper, cut out shapes for your toppings.

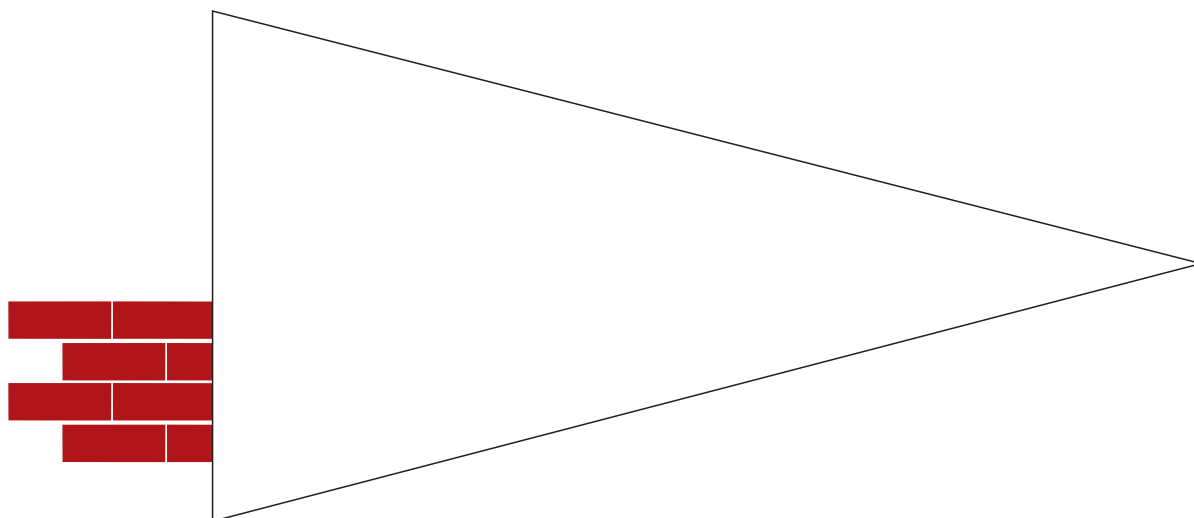
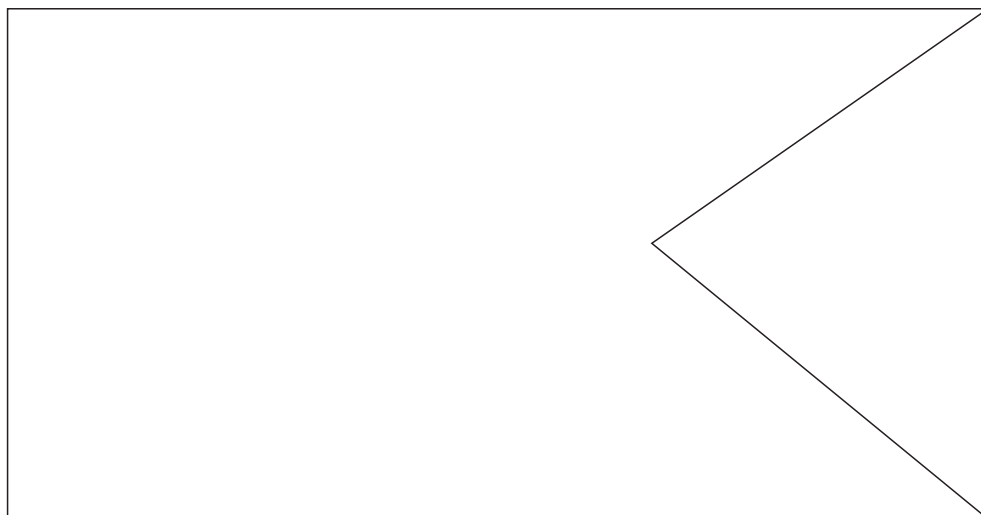
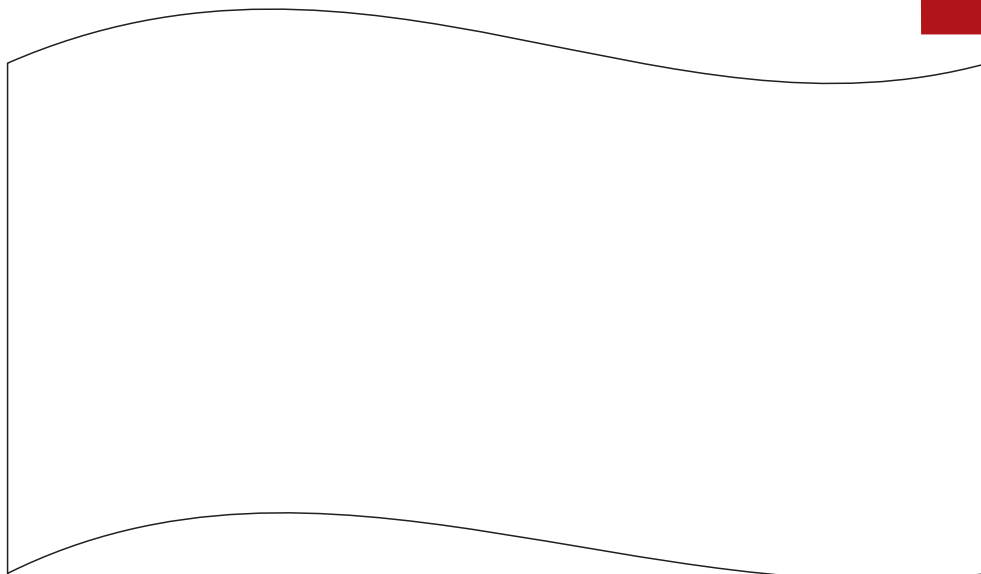
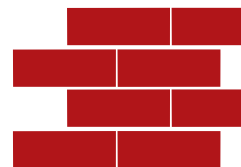
Finally, put it all together!
