

# PAPER PLATE MOTH & SLOTH

## MATERIALS FOR 1 MOTH & 1 SLOTH:

- 1 Paper Plate
- Scissor
- Paint - Green and Other Colors
- Pencil for Drawing
- Construction Paper
- Craft Glue
- Markers
- 1 Raw Bowtie Noodle
- Googly Eyes ( optional)
- Scotch Tape (optional)



## DIRECTIONS:

### First, create Sloth.

1. Cut a paper plate in half and cut out the border on one half of the plate. This is Sloth's body.
2. On the piece of the plate that remained after the border was cut off, draw a circle. Cut out the circle. This is Sloth's head.
3. Paint the head and body any color that you like. Add some green paint on the edge of the body for algae.
4. When the paint is dry, draw the face on the circle. Draw in the "racoon-like" part that goes around Sloth's eyes and glue on googly eyes or draw eyes with a magic marker.
5. Cut a 2" strip of construction paper to use as the branch and using a different color construction paper, cut out some leaves. Tape or paste the leaves onto the branch.
6. Draw 2 or 3 toes on both of Sloth's feet and then tape Sloth's feet onto the branch.
7. Tape on Sloth's head.

### Next, create Moth

8. With a magic marker, color an uncooked bow tie shaped pasta noodle. This is Moth!

### Finally, put it all together!

9. Glue the noodle onto Sloth's body.
10. Moth & Sloth are together again. Best Friends Forever!
